

Compuval Database

Halifax Dartmouth Real Estate Board

Hal MacMichael has pointed out that it would be wiser to prepare our sales data from the list of confirmed sales rather than the daily letter, since the latter refers only to accepted offers. We will do so in the future. It will entail a delay in the data entry since the Board's list does not reach us until the middle of the month. We understand that the Board is attempting to get the list out earlier in the month.

This will initially reduce the number of new sales entered into Compuval Datapase. However, we have started to load part of our existing data system into Compuval Database and have included the Cole Harbour sub-area in the July printout. This comprises approximately 400 additional sales and is included as a little bit of a bonus.

Unfortunately, the computer printout is only 132 spaces wide and, although it looks as though there is additional space available on the Compuval Database copy, this is an illusion. The copy you receive is a photocopy of the printout and the photocopy paper is simply wider than the printout.

We do not code the selling agent's name and listing date at the present time, but we do code 26 variables about each property, only 17 of which can be accommodated within the 132 space format.
